Daily working hours	Rostered times between 6:00am – 8:00pm (up to 8 hours)
Rest Day hours	Minimal hours required for forward campsite crew (next campsite)

Team purpose (outcomes)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Marking out the campsite and defining areas for different types of camping and luggage trucks. Using signage, flags and bunting to help cyclists navigate their way around the campsite. Direct riders and vehicles through entrances.
How the team gets the job done (actions)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Opportunities for pre Ride route trips to investigate campsites and layout draft plans for service locations Bunting areas off Erecting flags and signage Line marking access lanes Communication to team members and other teams about vehicles that arrive on site. Using detailed campsite maps to work from During early evening, packing up excess campsite equipment (removing non essential flags etc) and pack truck ready for early departure the next morning
