

## **Bicycle Victoria Regulation**

### **Election Material Regulation**

24 August 2009

1. Information concerning a candidate provided by the candidate to Bicycle Victoria may be included in election material produced, published or issued by Bicycle Victoria.
2. All election material produced, published or issued by Bicycle Victoria or **by or on behalf of** a candidate must comply with the following principles and requirements:
  - a) all election material produced, published or issued by or on behalf of a candidate must include a statement that the material has been authorised by the candidate;
  - b) election material should not be misleading, deceptive or false;
  - c) election material should not disclose confidential information belonging to the Bicycle Victoria;
  - d) election material should avoid unnecessarily bringing the Bicycle Victoria into disrepute; and
  - e) election material should not expose Bicycle Victoria to legal proceedings, prosecution or breach laws including defamation.
3. All election material produced, published or issued by Bicycle Victoria must have the prior approval of the Returning Officer. In determining whether to approve such election material, the Returning Officer must have regard to the principles and requirements set out in 2.
4. Any election material to be circulated within Bicycle Victoria premises or at Bicycle Victoria events must have the prior approval of the Returning Officer. In determining whether to approve such election material, the Returning Officer must have regard to the principles and requirements set out in 2
5. No campaign managers or agents acting on behalf of candidates will be recognised by the Returning Officer or Bicycle Victoria.
