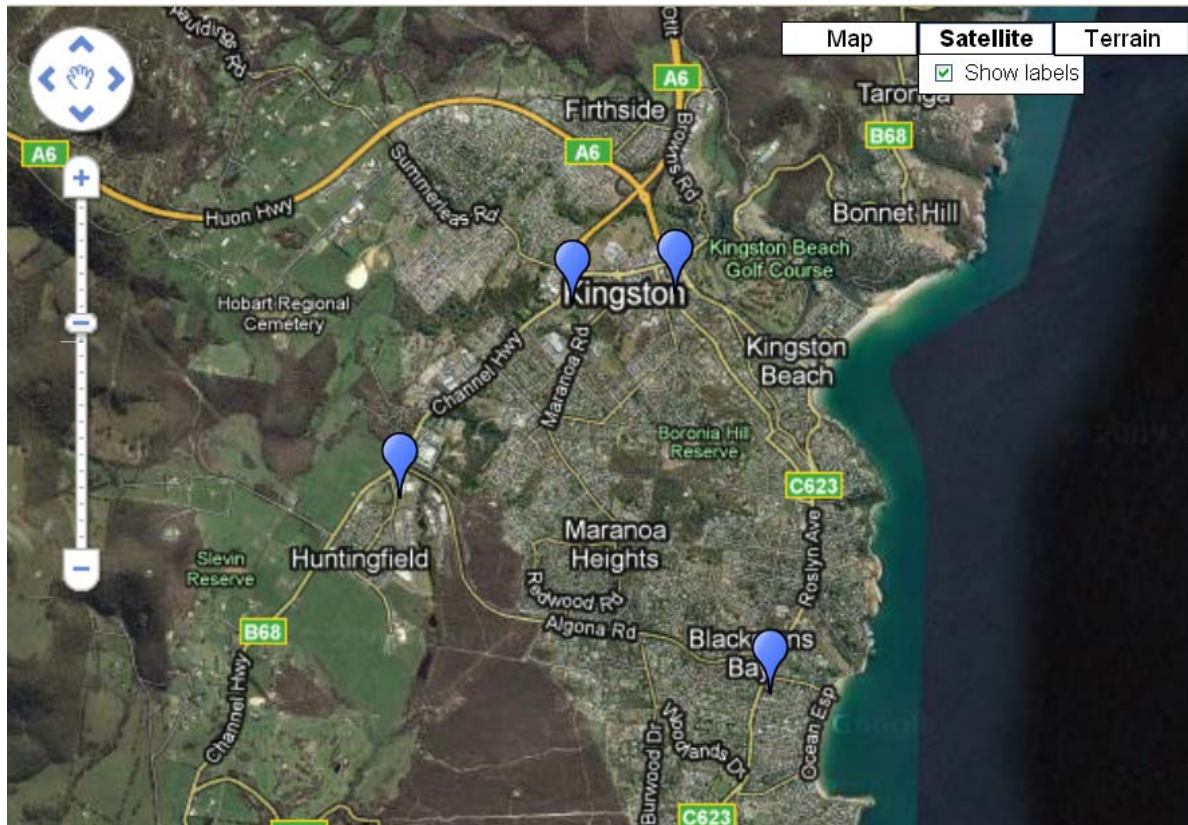
*The graphical images are screen captures that give an indication of the format of some of the data presentation in the final Super Tuesday reports that each council will receive.*

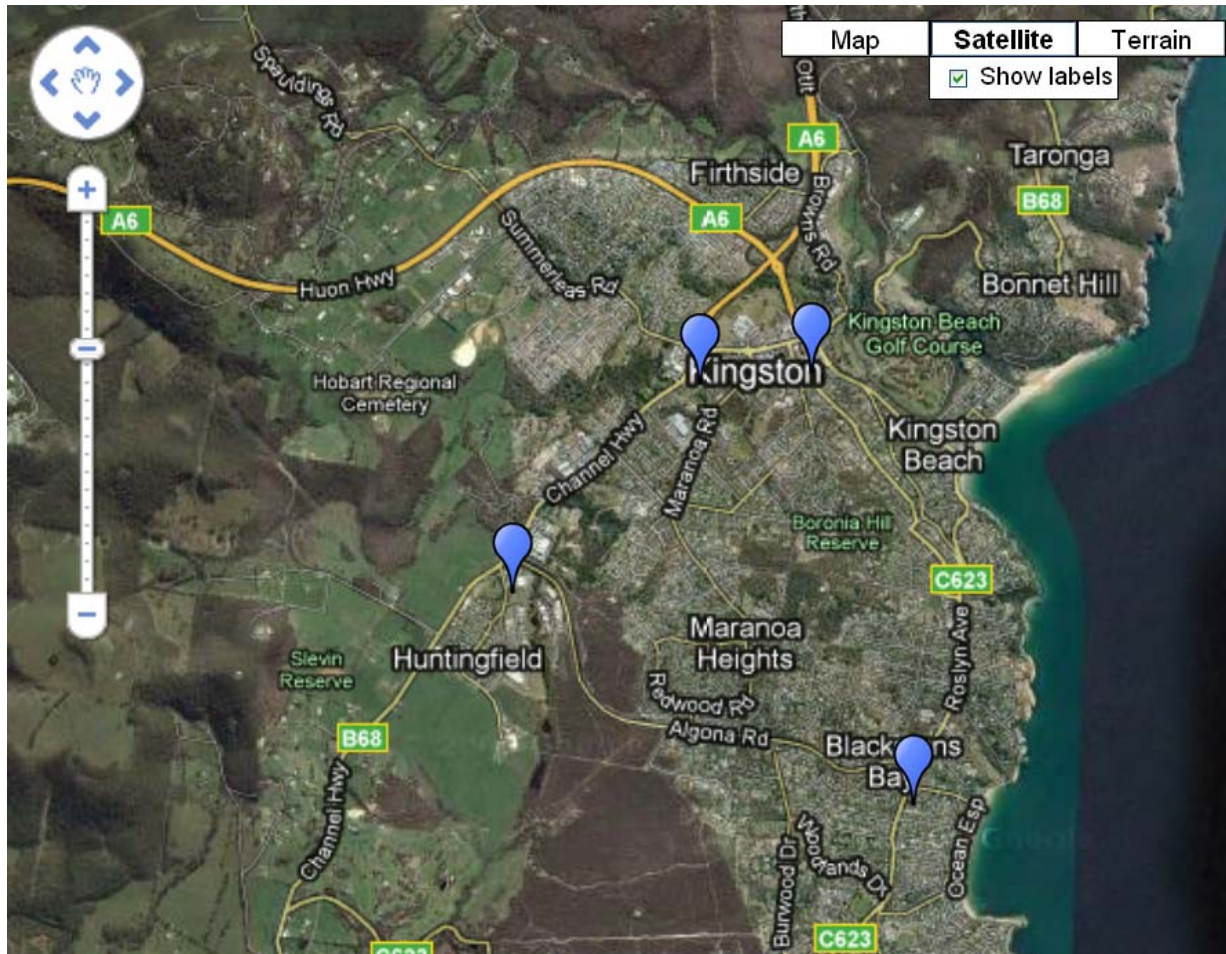
