How the team gets the job done (actions)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Positioning of Vendors on Main Street</li> <li>Manning cyclist gate entry, ensuring cyclists dismount on entry to camp</li> <li>Safely transporting Main Street equipment between sites</li> <li>Overseeing safety at each campsite</li> <li>Handing over to security at front gate each evening</li> </ul>
