Team	Medical Road
Operating hours	Approx 7am to 5pm
Daily working hours	Approx 7am to 5pm (depends on Riders riding ability to complete the route for the day)
Rest Day hours	May be rostered on to assist in covering Medical campsite for up to 2 hours.

The Challenge

To provide immediate assistance to Riders who are injured on the route and treat or refer onto local services

Team purpose (outcomes)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drive the rider route and respond to requests for assistance from Ride Participants and Route Control. • Provide medical assistance and referral to local services where appropriate.
How the team gets the job done (actions)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move about the bike route under the guidance of Route Control, and are on the scene in the event of crashes. • In the event of serious incidents, liaise with our Medical Clinic and local medical authorities in transporting riders to receive treatment. • Rotate through rest stops along the route, providing mobile First Aid assistance. • Ensure each first aid kit is continually replenished and available for use at rest stops and within the Medical Road team vehicles. • Record ride participant details, injuries and treatment notes

First day duties	Medical – road, on route.
Last day duties	Medical – road, on route.
Required start and end date	Required the day before official start day and completed duties after all cyclists through the finish on last day.
