Dear Mayor, Councillors and supporters of Ride2School,

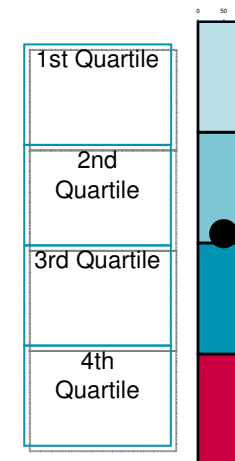

Top 4 Local Councils

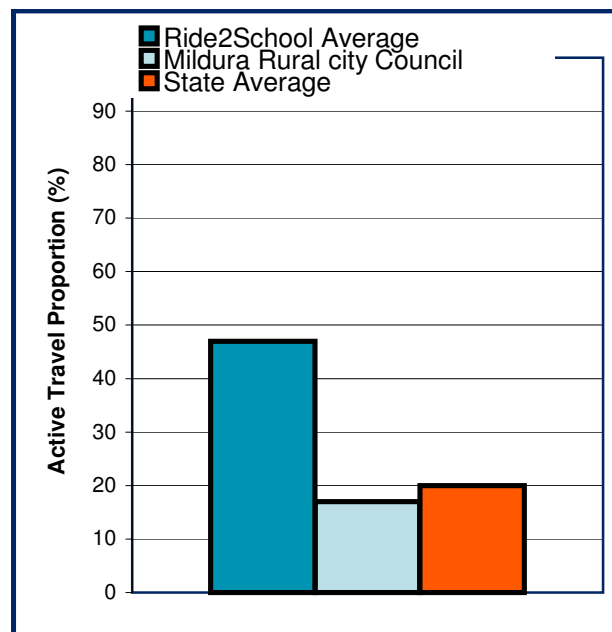

The registered school rank shows how many schools are registered in your council versus other councils. The active travel rank does the same, only for active travel percentage.



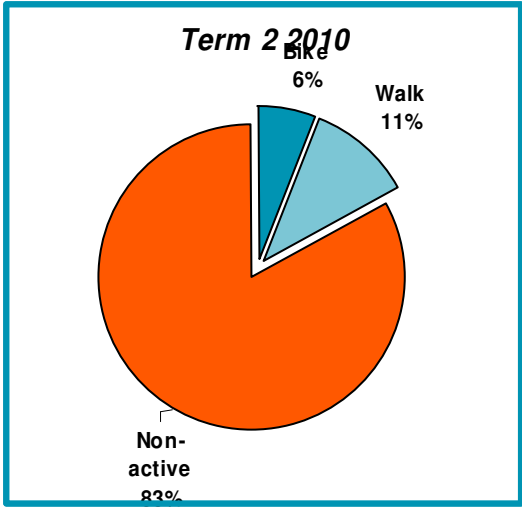
