The Challenge

To ensure there is adequate water, rubbish collection and equipment to look after the Riders on their journey

Team Outline	
Team purpose (outcomes)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To ensure riders have access to water along the route and that any hazards identified are removed
How the team gets the job done (actions)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Early morning the team drives along the route stopping at each rest area/water stop A truck with a water tank attached will be used at the first rest stop and will be driven by the team. This is a contingency if water has to be moved to another location along the route throughout the day. Put out either a bartlett (water bladder) and/or bidon bar (length of taps) at each stop at an appropriate place (e.g. level ground) Work closely with the water tanker drive to ensure bartletts are filled The team will be equipped with shovels and gloves to remove any identified hazards along the route and to contact route control of any as the team is one of the first out on the route At the end of the day, drive back along the route to collect and properly store all equipment. Keep in radio contact with route control to report progress Attend nightly briefings with Route Control if required
