Team purpose (outcomes)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To be the information and communication hub for the route. To action resources (Ambulance, paramedics etc.) where required. To be the central point for recording happenings on the route.
How the team gets the job done (actions)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The route control team operates from the campsite the riders are riding toward They have radio communication with route marshals, route services, signs, sag wagon, medical road and route operations They communicate with all of these teams They record all communications via a logging system and action event vehicles and route personnel where required Be a contact for alerting local authorities of any issues Throughout the day and at the end of the day, it is very important for the route control team to follow up on any medical incidents with the medical teams and document any changes/progress. Attend Route Team briefings nightly
