The Challenge

To get riders from town to town without losing their way and to alert them to any hazards to be aware of along the route

Team Outline

Team purpose (outcomes)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To clearly sign the route for riders to navigate their way and be warned of any obstacles. To sign the route for vehicles where appropriate.
How the team gets the job done (actions)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The team heads out early to have all signs in place for route opening time Also looking out for any hazards on the route. If any, need to report this back to route control for action. Collect all signs at end of the day when the route closes. Attend nightly briefings with Route Control team if required

Physical work	A lot of lifting – signs in and out of the vehicle
Customer contact	Behind the scenes
Sitting / Standing	Both – sitting in a car, standing to put out sign
Outdoor exposure	On route –all conditions

Qualifications	Standard Licence
Cash handling	None
Equipment loaned (need to return at end of Ride)	Vests, radio
Equipment supplied	Vehicle and signs
First day duties	Signs team duties
Last day duties	Signs team duties
Required start and end date	Required the day before official start day to familiarise with equipment and vehicle. Finished when last rider is through on last day. Some planning days (well prior to the Ride) are available to pack and group signs required.
