Dear Mayor, Councillors and supporters of Ride2School,

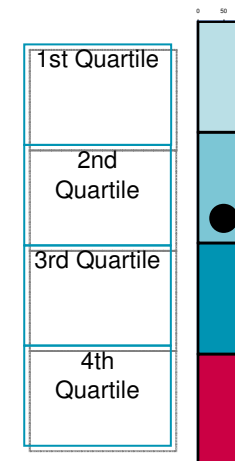

Top 4 Local Councils

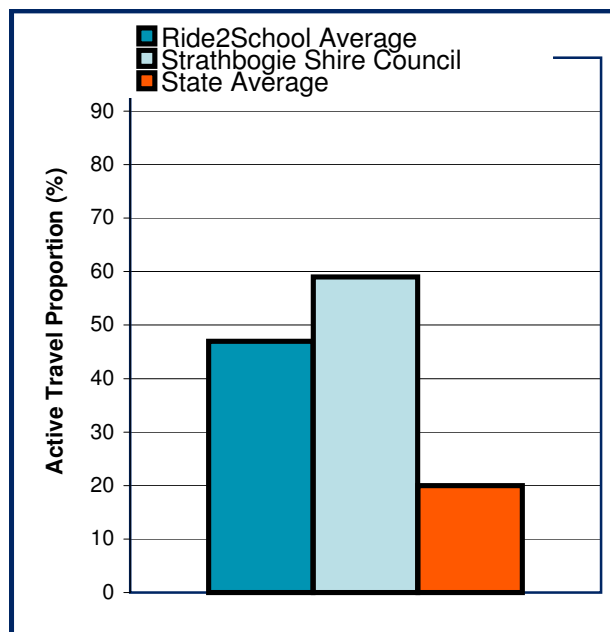

Gold Medal Challenge

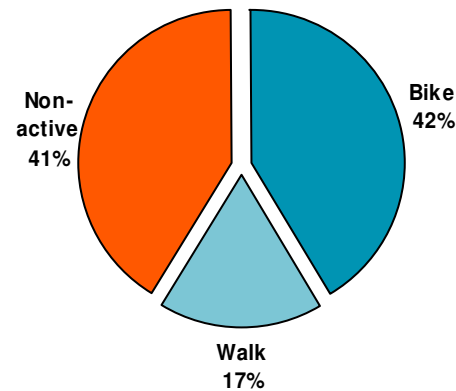
