Dear Mayor, Councillors and supporters of Ride2School,

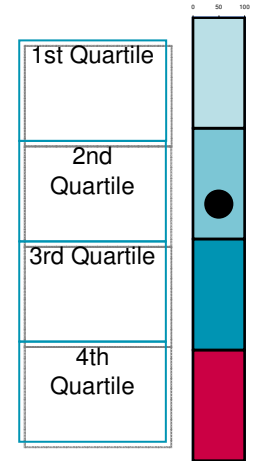

### Top 4 Local Councils

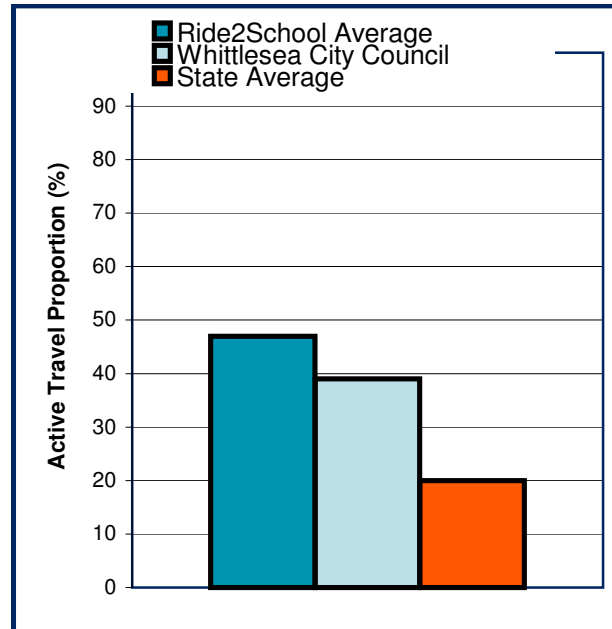

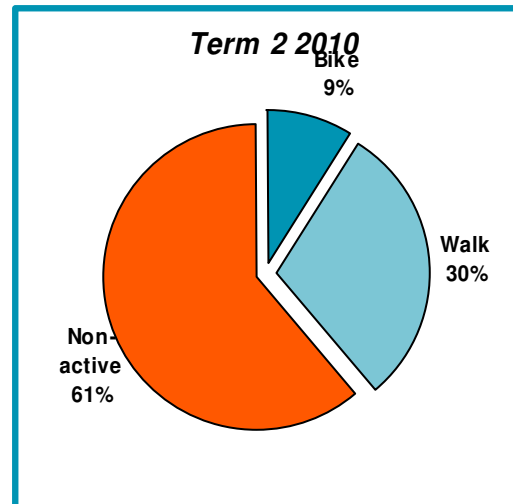
