



## Campaigns and Future Links

- 1 Battery Point Foreshore.**

A riverside trail from the existing trail at the CSIRO building at Castray Tee around Battery Point to the path along Marieville esplanade to Sandy Bay Rivulet has been a dream of Hobartians for many years.

Local campaigners continue to push for this trail and route options are currently being developed. There is some strong resistance to this trail from a small number of Battery Point residents but this will hopefully be overwhelmed by the strong community support for the trail.
- 2 Sandy Bay Road Bike Lanes**

This major road needs bike lanes as soon as possible. See Sandy Road Bay panel for further details.
- 3 Argyle St**

Hobart's first CBD bike lanes are about to be installed at the northern end of Argyle St. This is a good start but there is no reason why the lanes could not be installed immediately for the 2-way section length of the street. The photo below shows how much existing space there is on the road. Lanes were made from tape to show how easy it is.
- 4 A new promenade along Hobart's waterfront.**

The Cycleway is currently disconnected from Constitution Dock and Salamanca Place car parking along the waterfront. The six parked cars force bike riders to mix with pedestrians and vehicles that are loading and unloading fishing boats. Removing these
