<b>Physical work:</b>	General medical work
<b>Sitting / standing:</b>	Sitting and standing
<b>Outdoor exposure:</b>	Mostly undercover
<b>Rider contact:</b>	Yes, direct rider contact
<b>The Challenge – role, responsibilities and outcomes</b>	
<b>Role description:</b>	You will work with the team to setup, operate and pack down the Falls Creek First Aid Centre. You will provide first aid to the riders as they complete the ride.
<b>Key responsibilities:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To provide Medical Aid service to cyclists.</li> <li>• Refer ride participants to local medical care when appropriate.</li> <li>• In the event of serious incidents, contact an ambulance on 000, Liaise with our medical staff if a serious incident occurs.</li> <li>• Assessing riders for signs of fatigue, dehydration and hypothermia and aid these riders in an appropriate way.</li> <li>• To educate presenting Riders on how to minimise further injuries and illnesses.</li> <li>• Monitor ride participants who present to the medical clinic.</li> <li>• Record and log treatment details of each participant treated.</li> <li>• To refer ride participants to other event team members where appropriate.</li> </ul>
<b>Outcomes:</b>	The Care team will ensure completion of a safe ride by all riders where any Medical Aid issues are dealt with in a friendly professional manner. You will ensure a medical presence at the event village on event day. Volunteers will work safely and respectfully with each other.
