The Challenge – role, responsibilities and outcomes	
Role description:	As part of the sector management team you will liaise closely with the Route Sector Coordinator to ensure route sectors are closed according to the traffic management plan. You will be responsible for informing traffic controllers, marshals, sag wagons and riders of route sector closures.
Key responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Working closely with Vic Police and the Route Sector Coordinator, you will communicate and implement route sector closures. • Inform riders and communicate safety issues of staying on course after route sector closures. • Direct Riders that sit outside of the sector cut off times to ensure they do not continue outside of Route Support. • Direct sag wagon to attend to riders that have not made cut off times
Outcomes:	You will contribute to the successful traffic management of the rider route. The rider route will be closed according to the traffic management schedule, where no riders are remaining on route after dark. Volunteers will work safely and respectfully with each other.
