- 1 Photocopy Frequent Rider Passports**
- 2 Stamp school name on back and laminate**
- 3 Attach to a Ride2School lanyard and give one to each student**

A passport to frequent riding

Throughout the winter season, the numbers of students walking and riding to Holy Rosary Primary have increased because of a whole school commitment and the introduction of the Frequent Rider Passports.

The Frequent Rider Passports were launched at the start of Term 3 at an assembly, with prizes offered to the first rider and to the first walker to complete their passports.

Plenty of keen students collected 'passports' which were made up by supportive parent volunteers. Each student would get their passport 'clicked' when they walked or rode to school. Student volunteer, Dylan, took over from the admin person in 'clicking

the passports'. This intrepid student would arrive at school early each day, waiting at the front desk for student walkers and riders to arrive.

Three students, Nathan, Riley and Zac, were the first riders to complete passports – all on the same day. The trio persisted in riding to school through wind, rain and freezing temperatures and have each won a Cateye cycle computer. The first walker, Rhapsody completed her passport a short time

later and won a pedometer for her active efforts in getting to school.

Holy Rosary Primary has found the Frequent Rider Passports complement the school's commitment to active travel. They regularly hold Ride2School Days every term and find putting up posters is enough to get both students and parents excited. The parents are positive supporters of the school's approach to active travel, and the students love riding to school so much on Ride2School Days that the bike shed is overflowing!

In the words of Holy Rosary's Health Coordinator, Sally Bellingham, 'The Frequent Rider Passports have certainly encouraged more numbers of students to keep walking and riding to school'.
