TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

These Terms and Conditions of Entry ("Entry Terms") are designed to enable the Bicycle Network Victoria Mountain Bike Adventures programs from 16 September – 25 January 2012 to run smoothly and safely. By registering to participate in the camp, you the 'participant' accepts and agrees to be bound by these Entry Terms:

Entry Requirements

1. The participant must have a parent or guardian sign the entry form and consent to their participation in the camp and accept these terms and conditions.
2. The paper registration form must be received by 5pm, Friday 6 January 2012(AEST) to be eligible to register in the camp.
3. Bicycle Victoria may, in its absolute discretion and without giving reasons for its decision, accept or refuse an application for registration.

Cancellations

4. If the participant wishes to cancel his/her participation in the camp, the participant must notify Bicycle Victoria in writing, providing his/her name, address, and reason for cancelling.
5. Written cancellations received before 5pm, Friday 23rd December, 2012 will be refunded 50% of registration fee.
6. Written cancellations received before 5pm, Friday 30th December, 2012 (AEST) will be refunded 25% of registration fee.
7. No refunds will be offered for cancellations received after 5pm, Monday Friday 6th January, 2012 (AEST).
8. Except as otherwise stated in these Entry Terms, Bicycle Victoria is under no obligation to refund monies or entry fees due to non use, cancellation, failure to participate or dissatisfaction by the participant.
9. Operation of the Howman's Gap camp is dependent on a minimum number of persons booking the camp. If that number is not reached, we reserve the right to cancel the camp. Should minimum numbers for the Howman's Gap camp not be achieved, participants will be notified three business days before the camp and offered a full refund to a nominated bank account, or a place on the Lake Dewar Camp with a refund of the difference in price.

Camp Communication

10. Camp Communications will principally be made via email. The participant should therefore provide a valid email address.
11. It is the Ride Participant's responsibility to read all information that is made available on the Bicycle Victoria website, in email newsletters and all other literature concerning the program.

Closing Dates for entries

12. Entries for the camp close 5pm, Friday 6 January 2012(AEST), subject to availability.

Acknowledgment and Waiver

13. The participant acknowledges and agrees that participation in the camp is inherently dangerous and that he/she participates in the camp at his/her own risk.
14. In consideration of Bicycle Victoria permitting the participant to enter and participate in the camp, the participant hereby releases and indemnifies Bicycle Victoria, and their respective representatives from and against all and any claims, suits, demands, liabilities, loss and damage (including indirect and consequential loss), costs, expenses and, interest, whether pursuant to common law or statute, that the participant may suffer or incur arising from or connected with the participant's participation in the camp including as a result of the negligence, breach of duty, breach of care or other fault or responsibility of Bicycle Victoria, their respective representatives.

Compliance with Laws

15. During the camp, the participant must comply with all instructions given by Bicycle Victoria or any employees or officials representing Bicycle Victoria at the camp. Failure to do so may result in the participant being removed from the camp.
16. The Ride Participant must wear an Australian standard cycling helmet at all times during the program while riding a bicycle.

Health and Safety

17. The Participant is responsible for ensuring that he/she has adequately and appropriately prepared both physically and mentally for the Ride. If the Participant has any health issues or doubts prior to the Ride, he/she should immediately seek appropriate medical advice.
18. If, during the camp, the participant becomes ill or is injured, Bicycle Victoria or its representatives will endeavour to arrange medical transport, usually in an ambulance. Any medical transport will be at the participant's expense. (Bicycle Victoria recommends that participants hold current ambulance service membership and /or health insurance to cover such costs; Bicycle Victoria membership may include ambulance and bike crash insurance for bicycle accidents.) Refer to the policy details available at www.bv.com.au.
19. Where a participant becomes seriously ill or injured and are unable to participate in the camp activities, the participant will be considered no longer participating in the camp.
20. Where a participant is either expelled from, or chooses to discontinue the camp, the participant is responsible for their own transport and associated costs.

Common Sense

21. The Participant must ride in a safe and responsible manner during the Ride and use common sense at all times.
22. The participant must behave safely and responsibly during the camp and use common sense at all times.

Special requirements

23. Bicycle Victoria and its representatives will use all reasonable endeavours to cater for disabilities where reasonably able to do so.
24. Bicycle Victoria will consider written requests before the camp for personal assistance with specific health matters including refrigeration of prescription drugs.

Meal and dietary requirements

25. Bicycle Victoria offers non vegetarian, vegetarian, halal, and gluten free meals.
26. Any special meal option for the camp is provided by Bicycle Victoria as a service to the participants. Every effort is made by Bicycle Victoria and the appointed caterers to ensure that recipes and ingredients are controlled.

27. Bicycle Victoria and their caterers cannot however, guarantee that any meal or food item is exactly as described - contamination by allergens can occur that is beyond Bicycle Victoria and or the caterer's reasonable control.

Behaviour

28. Conduct which, in reasonable opinion of Bicycle Victoria, and its representatives is inappropriate may result in the participant being expelled from the camp.

Alcohol and Illicit drugs

29. Bringing, consuming or possessing alcohol, cigarettes, or illicit drugs on the camp is strictly prohibited. Under-age drinking will not be tolerated and may be referred to the Police.
30. The campsite is a non-smoking area. Smoking is prohibited for all participants of the program.

Privacy

31. Bicycle Victoria collects, uses, discloses and otherwise handles the participant's personal information in accordance with the terms of its Privacy Policy Statement (see www.bv.com.au (Search "privacy" for full details). All information remains the property of Bicycle Network.

Other

32. Bicycle Victoria and its representatives is not liable to the Participant for any loss, damage, cost or expense of any kind.
33. Bicycle Victoria may appoint an independent event operator such as YMCA to operate this event on its behalf, references to BicycleVictoria in these terms and conditions means Bicycle Victoria and the event operator and their respective staff, contractors and volunteers.
34. Bicycle Victoria reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to refuse to allow the participant to participate in the Ride or to remove the participant from the camp for breach of these terms and conditions or if it otherwise determines it appropriate to do so.
35. Bicycle Victoria and its representatives is not liable to the participant for any loss, damage, cost or expense of any kind, including but not limited to, the refund of the entry fee, if the participant is denied access to or removed from the Ride for any reason.
36. "Bicycle Victoria" means the Bicycle Victoria Incorporated ABN 41 026 835 903 and includes where appropriate Bicycle Victoria's employees, volunteers, agents, contractors and officers.
