

DETOUR AHEAD ON THE MAIN YARRA TRAIL

A section of the Main Yarra Trail between Dights Falls and Turner Street Abbotsford will be closed from **Monday 28 November**



A section of the Main Yarra Trail between Dights Falls and Turner Street (Abbotsford) will be closed from **Monday 28 November**.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to use the detour along Trenerry Crescent, as outlined on the map above.

The closure is due to construction works associated with a residential development at 80–110 Trenerry Crescent. The works are being undertaken by builder Hamilton Marino.

As part of the works, an 80-metre long retaining wall is being built. The wall will help stabilise the embankment, enabling Yarra Council to widen the path at this section.

The works are expected to take up to four weeks to complete, weather permitting. During this period, all efforts will be made to have this section of the path opened on weekends, and at other times when it is safe to do so.
