Cost: \$20,000 plus
Stores: up to 48 bikes.

Easy on the eye and the pocket...Mini Pods

Cost: approx. \$2,800 plus labour
Stores: up to 8 bikes and 8 scooters

| - can store bikes without locks | - not a secure enclosure |
| - stores scooters | - to overcome this a Flinders 48 is a much better option |
| - use sustainable materials | |

Economical option.... [Flat tops](#) & [Anaconda's](#)

Cost: approx. \$170 per 2 bikes plus labour
Stores: each rail can accommodate 2 bikes

| <i>Pros:</i> | <i>Cons:</i> |
| - cost effective | - won't secure scooters. |
| - easy to install | - to overcome this, the Cycle Pod is probably a better option. |
| - can lock bike frame & both wheels | |

On a budget?.... The [Freestyler Floor Stand](#) is for you

Cost: approx. \$340 (no labour costs)
Stores: up to 5 bikes

| - cost effective | - can't lock bike frames |
| - easy to install | - won't work well for smaller wheels i.e. 16" or smaller. |
| | - To address this, Flat Tops & Anaconda's are a better option |
