9. Part Way is OK!

Many students, particularly in some outer suburban and regional areas, live some distance from school. 'Part way is OK' is a means to ensure that these students can still have the opportunity to enjoy walking and riding to school on National Ride2School Day.

On National Ride2School Day encourage parents/ guardians to drop off and pick up children at a point closer to the school so that students can travel the rest of the way to school by foot, bike or scooter.

Part Way is OK enables students who live further distances away to participate in *some* level of active travel on the day. This will also minimise traffic congestion within your school parking areas at peak hour pick up and drop off times.
