

Ride2School - MIND.BODY.PEDAL

Terms and Conditions

- 1. The **organiser** is: the Ride2School Program; which is affiliated with Bicycle Network and the Victorian State Government whose registered office is at Level 4, 246 Bourke Street. Melbourne, Victoria. 3000
- 2. **Cost:** There is no entry fee or cost for participants or the school and no purchase necessary to participate in the initiative.
- 3. Entry: is only open to Victorian schools registered in the Ride2School Program
- 3.1 'Enter' is defined as teaching staff or the Ride2School contact that has opted in to register their school for the program.
- 3.2 Participants for the event will be chosen by the school.
- 4. **Privacy:** Participants will need to have a valid personal email to fully participate. The participant's email will only be used to send weekly tips and an event survey up to 6 weeks post event and will not be distributed to third parties.
- 5. **Bike riding:** All participating students must be able to ride a bike.
- 5.1 All students will be provided a mechanically checked bike and helmet of Australian and New Zealand Standard (AS/NZS 2063:2008).
 Students must wear the helmet at all times when riding and follow any instruction of the organisers while out riding.
- 5.2 Student will be taken outside of school grounds for the one (1) hour session of bike riding. This may include quite roads and shared paths. The bike ride will be a short ride, no more than 5km loop.
- 5.3 Three (3) suitably qualified adults, including at least one (1) qualified Bike Ed instructor and one trained in first aid will be present on the ride.
- 5.4 If weather is poor, for example heavy rain or hail the organisers will set up a stationary spin bike session undercover for the participants to experience.
- 5.5 **Medical treatment:** If required, the organisers will have a first aid qualified adult. If necessary the organisers/school will arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for the participant. actions being taken by the organisers and agree to meet all costs associated with such action
- 6. Photography and Identity: Photographic images and video footage will be taken by the organisers by participating in the event. These images will forever become property of the organisers, without monetary or other liability to me and the organiser may use the images on public domain via (but not limited to) Facebook, The Ride2School website. The organisers may also use these images for general promotion of its activities to other schools.
- 7. **Evaluation:** As a part of measuring the success of the initiative, participating schools must complete one (1) HandsUp! count per week in the lead up to their event day and following the event day. Participants will be asked how they travelled to school on particular days.
- 8. **Incentive prizes for surveys:** Participants who complete evaluation surveys will randomly go into a pool to be chosen for an incentive prize.



- 8.1 No cash alternative to the incentive prizes will be offered. The incentive prizes are not transferable. Incentive prizes are subject to availability and we reserve the right to substitute any incentive prizes with another of equivalent value without giving notice.
- 8.2 The organiser's decision in respect of all matters to do with the incentive prizes will be final and no correspondence will be entered into
- 8.3 The Incentive prizes and these terms and conditions will be governed by [Victorian] law and any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of [Victoria]
- 8.4 The winner agrees to the use of his/her name and image in any publicity material.

 Any personal data relating to the winner or any other entrants will be used solely in accordance with current [Australian] data protection legislation and will not be disclosed to a third party without the entrant's prior consent.
- 8.5 The winning participant will be contacted via email or by phoning the school.
