

Important information regarding changes to traffic conditions for Peaks Challenge Falls Creek on Sunday 13 March 2022

Event details

Date: Sunday 13 March 2022

Route: Looping bike ride starting and finishing at Falls Creek and travelling via

Mount Beauty, Harrietville, Dinner Plain, Omeo and Anglers Rest.

Distance: 235km

Participants: Approximately 2000 cyclists

The following roads will be closed on Sunday 13 March 2022:

Bogong High Plains Road	Full road closure	Glen Valley to Falls Creek	Closed to all vehicles, except Emergency Services and official event vehicles	12:00pm	8:30pm

In addition to the restricted vehicle access there will be changed traffic conditions in the area which may include speed reductions, presence of traffic controllers etc.

The treatments, which take into consideration the safety of all road users, have been implemented following extensive consultation with local council, VicRoads and Victoria Police.
