




Open Street Pilot: Brunswick East PS March 2021



On the day of the Open Street pilot, on average, 79.3 per cent of students used some form of active transport to get to school (e.g. walk, bike, scoot or skate). This reveals an increase of 18.3 per cent in active school travel on Open Street days, when compared to a normal school day in 2020.



Open Street Pilot survey



The Open Street pilot events were given an average rating of 4.61 out of 5 by respondents, indicating a high level of satisfaction. Interestingly, for the question “Should traffic be reduced on the street”, the responses of parents who drove their children to school (average score 4.21, equivalent to ‘Agree’ or ‘Strongly Agree’) were almost identical to parents whose children used active travel (average score 4.27)
