What is your view regarding the current active transport infrastructure in your electorate?

There is a serious lack of bicycle infrastructure in the area, and what little does exist is often highly (highly!) inadequate. We should be encouraging people to take up active transport, but as things stand there are many people who don't feel safe doing so.

What actions will you take to improve active transport in your electorate?

The Victorian Greens have committed \$2.5 billion over the next four years to build hundreds of kilometers of safe and separated bike lanes. And I fully support.
