RESPONSE:

"Since being elected in 2018, I have been a strong advocate for improving active transport infrastructure in the Box Hill electorate.

Over the last term, the Andrews Labor Government has:

- Completed the remaining sections of the Box Hill -Ringwood shared path
- Completed a feasibility study on the Box Hill Hawthorn shared path
- Commenced construction on the level crossing removal project in Mont Albert and Surrey Hills, which will include a shared path (or standalone bicycle path) between Union Road, Surrey Hills and Churchill Street, Mont Albert.
- Allocated money to plan for a new pedestrian connection across Elgar Road (at Windsor Crescent), providing direct access for walkers and cyclists to the path network around Surrey Park

Encouraging more active transport users requires the provision of safe infrastructure, and I will continue to advocate for more funding to progress important local projects, such as the Hawthorn to Box Hill shared path."
