**What is your view regarding the current active transport infrastructure in your electorate?**

It is woefully inadequate. There is a huge need to create safe cycling and walking paths across the Morwell electorate, and especially to enable access to public transport options, to allow children and young people to safely cycle to schools.

**What actions will you take to improve active transport in your electorate?**

The Greens have detailed and fully costed policies on sport and recreation, climate change, that demonstrate our strong support for building and maintaining active transport infrastructure. In Morwell, we could do with more linkages between towns as well as safe pathways within the larger towns of Traralgon, Moe, Morwell and Churchill.
