Starting in Orbost on Saturday 25th November, we'll travel through the beautiful towns of Buchan, Lakes Entrance, Paynesville, Sale, Port Albert and Fish Creek before ending in Wonthaggi on Sunday 3rd December. This event couldn't happen without the support of up to 300 volunteers. Volunteering is a great way to share your skills, learn new ones, meet likeminded people, support the bike riding community, explore the Victorian countryside and be a part of an iconic event. The Role

As part of the Campsite Services Team, you will be setting up the campsites services to ensure they are all ready to go and then maintaining watch to fix any issues before they become problems. You'll be working across the sites to ensure there is sufficient supply of power and water for the different campsite areas. You'll also be checking all the equipment is functional, accessible and being used correctly. You will be working with grey water at times. You're also the go-to team for when things go wrong, so general mechanical problem solving comes in handy.

Your role may include:

- Setting up and packing down generators and connecting power.
- Setting up and packing down portable water tanks and connecting hoses.
- Filling water tanks and keeping generators running.
- Providing technical knowledge to other teams.
- Troubleshooting issues; including power, water, vehicles and mechanical problems.
