<u>The Great Vic Bike Ride</u> is a rolling bike riding and camping festival that moves to a new town each day. The 2023 edition will take us from the Snowy to Sea, showcasing all the best parts of Gippsland. Starting in Orbost on Saturday 25th November, we'll travel through the beautiful towns of Buchan, Lakes Entrance, Paynesville, Sale, Port Albert and Fish Creek before ending in Wonthaggi on Sunday 3rd December. This event couldn't happen without the support of up to 300 volunteers. Volunteering is a great way to share your skills, learn new ones, meet likeminded people, support the bike riding community, explore the Victorian countryside and be a part of an iconic event. The Role

As part of the Catering Team, you will have the important responsibility of serving the riders their meals each day. You will need to be up before the crack of dawn to serve breakfast from 6am and return later in the day for the dinner service. It's a split shift, but it means you'll have plenty of time during the day to explore the towns we visit or take some time to relax.

Your role will include:

- Serving meals to riders and volunteers (please note you won't be required to do any food preparation or cooking).
- Maintaining a clean and hygienic service area.
- Assisting with the set up and pack down of the service area.
- Assisting with the cleaning of storage boxes.
- Directing riders to serving bays.
- Lugging boxes between front and back of house (optional).
