The Great Vic Bike Ride is a rolling bike riding and camping festival that moves to a new town each day. The 2023 edition will take us from the Snowy to Sea, showcasing all the best parts of Gippsland. Starting in Orbost on Saturday 25th November, we'll travel through the beautiful towns of Buchan, Lakes Entrance, Paynesville, Sale, Port Albert and Fish Creek before ending in Wonthaggi on Sunday 3rd December. This event couldn't happen without the support of up to 300 volunteers. Volunteering is a great way to share your skills, learn new ones, meet likeminded people, support the bike riding community, explore the Victorian countryside and be a part of an iconic event. #### The Role

As part of the Lunch Team, you will have the important responsibility of ensuring riders receive their lunch each day, giving them the fuel to keep them going to the finish line! You will be setting up and packing down the lunch site at a new location each day, handing out lunches and providing great customer service. If you want to be amongst the action and follow the journey the riders take across the event, this is the team for you!

Your role will include:

- Travelling from the campsite to the lunch site each morning.
- Setting up and packing down the lunch site equipment, including marquees, tables, chairs, bike parking and signage.
- Marshalling riders safely into the site and ensuring a smooth flow of riders through the area.
- Checking the riders' passports and handing out the correct lunch type.
- Providing excellent customer service and answering questions from riders and the public.
- Ensuring the site is kept clean, tidy and free of litter.
