The Event

The Great Vic Bike Ride is a rolling bike riding and camping festival that moves to a new town each day. The 2023 edition will take us from the Snowy to Sea, showcasing all the best parts of Gippsland. Starting in Orbost on Saturday 25th November, we'll travel through the beautiful towns of Buchan, Lakes Entrance, Paynesville, Sale, Port Albert and Fish Creek before ending in Inverloch on Sunday 3rd December. This event couldn't happen without the support of up to 300 volunteers. Volunteering is a great way to share your skills, learn new ones, meet likeminded people, support the bike riding community, explore the Victorian countryside and be a part of an iconic event. The Role

As part of the Riding Marshal Team, you will play a key role in ensuring riders are safe, informed and supported when out on the road. Assigned to specific marshal point each day, you will be ensuring riders follow the route, avoid any hazards and safely navigate tricky intersections and turns. You will be riding to your designated spot ahead of the riders and remain on-point until the last rider comes through before being relieved and riding on.

Your role will include:

- Waking up bright and early each day to ride to your allocated position before the first rider arrives.
- Providing directions to riders as needed at your specific marshal point.
- Ensuring riders are heading in the right direction and alerting them to any potential hazards on the route.
- Providing encouragement to riders.
- Communicating with your team leader and other members of the event team.
- Escalating any incidents to Event Assistance.
- Answering questions from riders and the public.
