As part of the Volunteer Operations Team, you will play a crucial role in ensuring the wider volunteer team have a great experience on event! You'll be responsible for setting up and packing down the volunteer support area each day – a place where the team can go to relax, have a cup of coffee, charge their phone and socialise with other volunteers. You'll also have the important job of setting up and packing down the volunteer pop-up tents each day.

Your role may include:

- Setting up and packing down volunteer tents and overseeing their allocation to volunteers.
- Setting up tables, marquees and other equipment for the volunteer support area and moving it from campsite to campsite.
- Assisting with distributing volunteer uniforms on the first day.
- Ensuring that all volunteers get their lunches each day, by transporting them to the volunteer support area.
